- 1  **Mon Roc Ugni Blanc/Colombard 2014, Languedoc, France** £4.25 £5.50 £14.95
Aromas of peach, citrus and grapefruit leading to a crisp, refreshing finish.
- 2  **Santa Alvara Sauvignon Blanc 2014 – Chile** £4.75 £5.75 £15.95
A crisp Sauvignon offering aromas of gooseberry and elderflower.
- 3  **Kleinkloof Chenin Blanc 2014 – Paarl, South Africa** £5.25 £6.50 £16.95
Very attractive nose with lots of tropical fruits such as pineapple, guava and citrus fruit, carrying on to a delightful crisp finish.
- 4  **Pinot Grigio, Terre del Noce 2014 - Veneto, Italy** £5.45 £6.75 £17.95
Vines grown at high altitude by the famous winery at Mezzacorona, has created the ultimate Pinot Grigio. Fresh, dry, youthful and pure, this wine is extremely elegant and clean with delicate flavours of citrus fruit.
- 5  **Chardonnay Coleccion Finca La Colonia, Norton - Argentina** £5.95 £7.50 £19.50
Delicate aromas of pear and red apple lead to a refined, refreshing palate in which ripe fruit is balanced by subtle savoury and vanilla notes.
- 6 **Picpoul de Pinet Beauvignac 2013, Languedoc, France** £17.95
This is a perfect example of why Picpoul has become so popular. It has elegant aromas of citrus, pear and white flowers, and a crisp, mineral palate ideally suited to seafood.
- 7 **Finca La Colonia Torrontés, Norton 2014 - Argentina** £17.95
Gold medal winner in the Sommelier Wine Awards 2014. A sophisticated, dry, elegant rendition of this aromatic grape variety, combining minerality with white peach and floral notes such as rose & jasmine.
- 8 **Deakin Estate Riesling, Victoria 2011 - Australia** £18.50
A crisp, dry Riesling, with characteristic lemon aromas and a touch of floral complexity. Light-bodied yet full of personality, this wine is a versatile match for food.
- 9 **Regaleali Bianco, Tasca d'Almerita** £18.95
Run on the best principles of agricultural aristocracy, the Tasca family have had one eye on quality and the other on experimentation with local grape varieties, resulting in wine of inspirational character.
- 10 **Muscadet sur Lie Carte d'Or, Sauvion 2014 – Loire, France** £19.95
Bright aromas of apple and lemon peel with some minerality. Crisp, dry palate with vibrant fruit flavours.
- 11 **La Contessa Gavi di Gavi, Bruno Broglia 2013 - Italy** £20.95
This top selection shows great refinement and minerality on the nose, with a nutty savouriness on the palate. Taut, concentrated and structured, it sets the benchmark for great Gavi.
- 12 **Pinot Grigio Riserva, Mezzacorona 2013 – Trentino, Italy** £22.95
Gold medal winner in the Sommelier Wine Awards 2014. A complex and quite weighty style of Pinot Grigio, with notes of spice and pear, a ripe, round texture, and a whisper of smoke.
- 13 **Sauvignon Blanc Coopers Creek, Marlborough 2014 – New Zealand** £24.95
Vibrant gooseberry, passionfruit and nectarine backed with hints of herbaceousness. Impressive weight of flavour on the palate with richness and texture and a long finish.
- 14 **Sancerre, Domaine Cherrier 2014 – Loire, France** £29.95
Fresh citrus on the nose, with a palate of melon and stone fruit balanced with subtle grassy notes and some bright minerality.
- 15 **Chablis 1er Cru Fourchaume, Brocard 2012 – Burgundy, France** £45.00
Gold medal winner in the Sommelier Wine Awards 2014. An exotic nose of pineapple & mango is followed by a harmonious palate with an added hint of honeyed fruit, and a refreshing mineral finish.

RED WINE

- 19  **Mon Roc Carignan/Merlot 2014, Languedoc, France** £4.25 £5.50 £14.95
Inviting aromas of red fruits are lifted by a hint of pepper and cinnamon. The palate is smooth and spicy, finishing on more berry fruit.
- 20  **First Fleet Shiraz 2014 – South-Eastern Australia** £4.95 £5.95 £16.95
A vibrant Shiraz displaying ripe blackberry fruits in a modern, easy-drinking style. The fruit mixes with spice on the smooth-textured palate making this an incredibly delightful wine.
- 21  **Merlot, Gran Hacienda, Santa Rita – Chile 2014** £5.45 £6.75 £17.95
 This Merlot has a complex aroma combining ripe black fruits and sweet plums with vanilla and spice notes. Concentrated palate, with a very ripe, smooth structure.
- 22  **Malbec Coleccion Finca La Colonia 2013 - Argentina** £5.95 £7.50 £19.50
 Silver medal winner in the **Sommelier Wine Awards 2014**. Deep red colour with violet hues. Aromas of ripe red fruit, cassis and black pepper, with more fruit and a touch of spice on the palate.
- 23  **Candidato Tempranillo 2014 – Spain** £4.95 £5.95 £16.50
This is an easy drinking red wine. Warm, soft red fruit and herbs with a touch of spice.
- 24 **Ricossa Terza Generazione Barbera, Piemonte 2013 – Italy** £16.95
 Juicy cherry fruit leaps out of the glass from this smooth, refreshing Barbera. A classic grape of north-west Italy, it produces an exuberant, medium-bodied style with hints of spice.
- 25 **Montalto Organic Nero d’Avola 2014 - Italy** £17.95
 Notes of ripe red fruits, sweet spices and liquorice. The fruit flavours continue generously on the palate
- 26 **Gran Hacienda Carmenère, Santa Rita 2014 - Chile** £17.95
 Rich aromas of ripe, red fruit and fragrant spices dominate the bouquet. On the palate, it is fresh, medium bodied and elegant, with a fruity flavour, a round mouthfeel, and a pleasant, lingering finish.
- 27 **Côtes-du-Rhône Domaine de Seraphin 2013 - France** £18.95
 Aromas of raspberry and black cherry, with a dusting of white pepper; smooth yet lively on the palate.
- 28 **Promesa Rioja Crianza 2012 - Spain** £19.95
 A classic style of Rioja, with strawberry, blackberry and rhubarb fruit flavours taking on a vanilla and cocoa smoothness during twelve months in oak barrels.
- 29 **Santa Cristina Rosso, Tuscany 2013 – Italy** £21.50
 Bronze medal winner in the **Sommelier Wine Awards 2014**. Intense fresh fruit aromas with pleasant floral hints. Well-structured, generous and soft on the palate, with lingering fruit notes on the finish.
- 30 **Mount Holdsworth Pinot Noir, Wairarapa 2012 – New Zealand** £23.95
 An exuberantly fruity Pinot Noir that offers bright strawberry and cherry aromas, as well as a finely etched medium-bodied palate of satisfying structure and length.
- 31 **Morgon Domaine Jean Descombes, Beaujolais 2011 - France** £24.50
 Silver medal winner in the **Sommelier Wine Awards 2014**. Morgon is one of the ‘senior’ Beaujolais crus, and this is suitably grand, with concentrated black cherry fruit and notes of kirsch, red fruits, floral and violets. Excellent structure and good length.
- 32 **Valley Floor Shiraz, Langmeil 2012 – Australia** £29.95
 Silver medal winner in the **Sommelier Wine Awards 2014**. A quintessential expression of Barossa Shiraz, with aromas of plum and mulberry offset by milk chocolate, cinnamon and pepper.
- 33 **Château Perron, Lalande-de-Pomerol, Bordeaux 2009 – France** £35.00
 Supple and fleshy, with the generous plum/berry fruit of the appellation’s Merlot, lifted by a seam of mineral elegance and some fresh currant notes from the Cabernets.
- 34 **Chateauneuf-du-Pape, Domaine du Vieux Lazaret 2011, Rhone** £39.95
 An immensely fruity nose, with spicy and balsamic notes, then great complexity on the palate: power, finesse, and an incredibly long, mineral-fresh finish.
